

Impact study evaluation findings on early trial versions of Coaching eBooks*





Reading attitudes were significantly better in the Coaching eBook classes, particularly in Year 5.



Teachers felt that:



The Coaching eBooks helped engage children with reading.

*Researchers from the School of Education at the University of Southampton conducted a Randomized Controlled Trial for one term (Summer 2018) to find out the impact of using prototypes (early trial versions) of Coaching eBooks. The findings informed pre-publication development of the Oxford Reading Buddy digital reading service.
